AN ORDINANCE CREATING A CITIZEN ADVISORY MOBILITY COMMITTEE FOR THE CITY OF NEWARK, OHIO.

WHEREAS, This Council has determined that a committee should be created to provide for community and citizen input to guide city staff in making decisions related to the planning, prioritization and implementation of mobility-related programs, including pedestrian facilities, bicycle facilities and transit operations and facilities; and

WHEREAS, This Council has determined that a committee should be created to reinforce the Council-approved legislation pertaining to Complete Streets; and

WHEREAS, This Council has determined that a committee should be created to review and provide comments on projects, grant applications, and programs related to mobility; and

WHEREAS, This Council has determined that a committee should be created to keep Council members informed on mobility-related efforts and priorities; and

WHEREAS, This Council, pursuant to the authority of Articles 3.07 (B) and 11.07 of the Newark City Charter, has the authority to create such a committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, COUNTY OF LICKING, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1: A Citizen Advisory Mobility Committee shall be and is hereby established pursuant to the authority granted this Council under Articles 3.07 (B) and 11.07 of the Newark City Charter.

Section 2: Such Board shall consist of 7-9 members, including 2 Council members (1 from each party) and 5-7 members of the public, appointed by the Mayor. All appointed members shall serve for terms of four years with half serving staggered terms. Members shall serve without pay. Vacancies, whether by expiration or otherwise, shall be filled in the same manner.

Section 3: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest time permitted by Article 4.07 of the Newark City Charter.
