During the last 3 years in December, Licking County saw 11 people die in motor vehicle crashes. Of those, 3 involved drivers who were impaired.



From 2013-2017, there were 25 crashes leading to injury in Licking County during the month of December that involved an alcohol-impaired driver.



Last year on Christmas Eve in Licking County, there were 2 fatal crashes that involved an alcohol-impaired driver.
