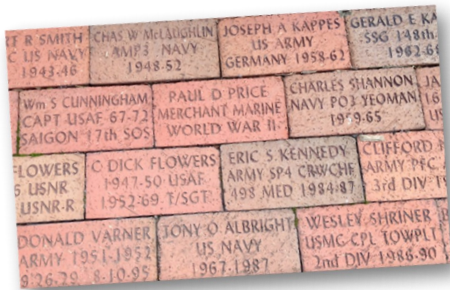


VETERANS WALK OF HONOR

The Veterans Walk of Honor is located in Veterans Park at North 6th Street between West Main and West Church Streets. It lines the path in front of the Buckingham House, home to the Licking County Historical Society, along with the Sherwood-Davidson House, and the Heisey Glass Museum. The Veterans Walk of Honor is a beautiful walkway that serves as a reminder of those individuals who have given of themselves and answered the call of duty so that we might continue to enjoy the freedoms with which we are blessed. Engraved 4"x8" bricks honor those brave individuals who are serving, or have served our country. All proceeds from the sale of the bricks go towards maintenance of Veterans Park. Orders placed by April 15th are installed for Memorial Day. Orders placed by September 30th are installed for Veterans Day.

Dates should be years of service. Leave a space between words or groups of letters or numbers. Orders involving multiple bricks to be placed together must be so stated on each order form and returned together.
